Project Goals:

- Select the beads, threads, and materials needed.
- Plan a simple design or pattern.
- String the beads and assemble the jewellery or phone chain.
- Check the final product and secure all knots properly.

Skills Learned:

- Creative thinking and innovation jewellery pieces.
- Team work during planning and crafting activities.

Challenges and solution:

- Choosing a jewellery design.
- Students make a simple sketch first.
- Finding the right materials.
- Collect beads, wire, clay, and threads in advance.
- Difficulty in shaping or assembling pieces.
- Use basic tools and follow easy steps.



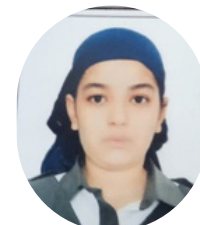

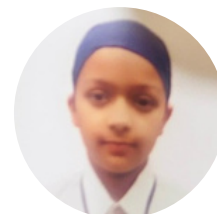
